Exploits of Olaf Haraldsson (St Olaf), patron saint of Norway, are described in Icelandic sagas, including the *Fagrskinna* (c.1220) and the *Morkinskinna* (c.1225). He is a significant figure for London and for Southwark Cathedral. He is reputed to have helped save London in the early 11th century from the Danes. Joining forces with Ethelred the Unready, Olaf's longboats pulled down the wooden London Bridge.

A statue of St Olaf appears in the cathedral screen at Southwark.

The words of this piece are taken from the Office of St Olaf, set to medieval/fantasy-inspired music.
